Personalizing Your Cabinets



Tilt-Out Sink Trays transform the drawer front into convenient, out-of-sight storage for small items, soap, and scouring pads. In some cases, the tray includes a ring holder to keep valuable jewelry from falling off or getting dirty from work around the kitchen.



Spice Racks can be incorporated into a kitchen design to help ease the cooking process. The racks come in a variety of forms including simple drawer inserts, shelves on the back of cabinet doors (right), and dedicated cabinets. As shown on the left, they can also be hidden behind decorative molding or legs.



Waste Basket Kits allow a much cleaner look by hiding the trash can in a base cabinet. In many cases, multiple baskets can be included, allowing easier recycling and capturing of soiled kitchen linens. Laundry hamper kits are also available for bathroom cabinets.

A variety of **Cutlery or Drawer Organizer trays** are available. These trays come in a variety of sizes and designs to meet a homeowner's needs. In some cases, they can help protect valuable silverware (far right).





Tray Dividers create partitions for the easy storage of cookie sheets, serving trays, and baking pans. No longer will reaching for a cookie tray result in an avalanche of baking pans!



Appliance Garages provide out-of-sight countertop storage for toasters, mixers, and other small appliances. The garages come in corner units and straight units, with a hide-away or a tambour door.

Wine Racks provide a great way to store wine in the kitchen or bar area. The racks are typically available in a lattice (right) or scalloped design.



Rollout Trays are an excellent option to maximize cabinet storage space, while maintaining easy access. Trays come in two heights ... one for shorter items (left) and one for taller items (right).

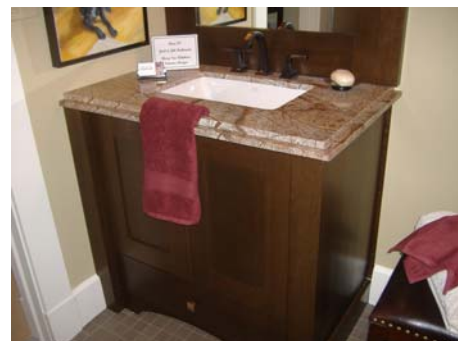


Award Winning Bathroom Project
